## Market Trend Summary

Thanks to gains in the detached segment of the market, February sales rose to the best monthly level seen in over a decade. New listings also rose but not enough to causes any significant change in the low inventory situation playing out in the city.

With a sales-to-new-listings ratio of 74 per cent and months of supply of only three months, it is no surprise that prices are trending up the city.

Detached sales have improved across most price ranges, but products priced between \$400,000 - \$500,000 saw a significant jump in the share of sales going from only 5 per cent of the sales last year to 14 per cent of all the sales. The shift in distribution could be one of the factors impacting the significant year-over-year gain recorded this month.
