Market Trend Summary

Further easing in October sales contributed to the year-to-date decline of nearly 12 percent. While sales have eased, they remain well above long term trends for the city and levels reported prior to covid. The pullback in sales has been driven by declines in homes priced below \$500,000, which can be related to the near 15 percent drop in new listings in that price range.

While conditions are more balanced today than they were earlier in the year, much of this is due to shifts in demand rather than supply. Overall, the months of supply remains relatively low for this market and we continue to see price growth for most property types. On a year-to-date basis average prices have improved by nearly three percent, with detached gains that have neared five percent.
