Market Trend Summary

Sales and new listings started off 2024 at nearly the same levels as last January. However, thanks to the steady decline throughout 2023, January inventory levels totalled a mere 150 units. Inventory levels are half of the levels we traditionally see at the start of the year and are currently at the lowest January level reported since 2002.

Low supply choices relative to sales have been supporting price growth in this market. While seasonality and the composition of sales can create significant monthly variation in average and median home prices, compared to last year prices have risen.
